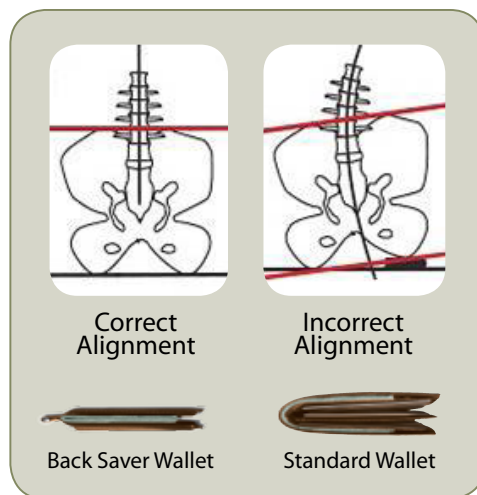

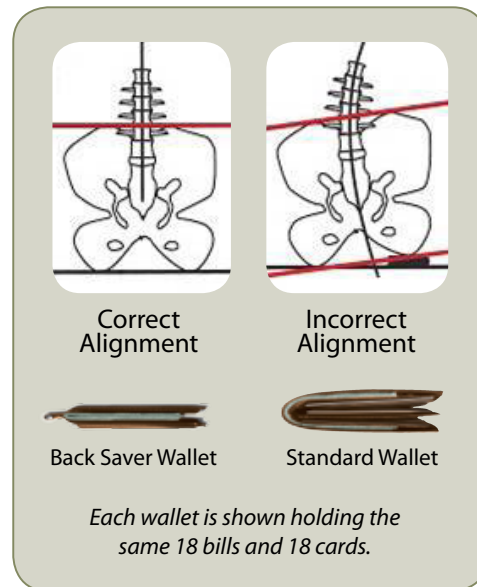

Organizing your Back Saver Wallet

1. Pull contents from old wallet and separate into piles: a cash pile, a card pile, and a paper pile.
2. Reduce paper clutter by filing receipts, storing business cards or transferring the contact information to your cell phone.
3. Insert cards into Back Saver Wallet:
 - ID cards and/or membership cards in two outer slots.
 - Put bank cards in one inner slot.
 - Put remaining cards in the other inner slot.
4. Place money under the money clip:
 - Clip spring may be tightened or loosened.
 - Pull clip from the wallet.
 - Rotate to right to tighten or left to loosen.
5. Slip into front trouser pocket, shirt pocket or carry in jacket.
